



Board Member Expectations-June 2017

What would it mean to join the board of directors for Love In the Name of Christ of Central Oregon?

In very practical terms...

1. **Get excited** about our work and share it with your friends. This may mean speaking to your colleagues at work or at church, inviting friends to learn more, or simply talking about your time on the board with family. We hope that you are so enthused by what is happening here that you can't help but share it!
2. We have **10-12 full board meetings** each year. The annual meeting schedule is scheduled for January each year. Currently, monthly board meetings are scheduled on the third Thursday of each month at 4:00 p.m. in Redmond (*with occasional exceptions – holidays, in-service, etc.*).
3. You will be asked to serve on a committee. This may involve an additional **5-10 committee meetings** per year. These meetings may be scheduled at any time, at the discretion of the committee chair.
4. You will be asked to make a **contribution** to Love INC of Central Oregon's annual fund that is meaningful and significant to you. Our goal each year is 100% board participation.
5. You will be asked to **attend volunteer appreciation events and fundraising events** if possible, and to invite your network where applicable and comfortable to do so. Important dates coming up are: currently being considered.
6. You will be asked to participate in Love INC National board member **training** within the first 3 months of beginning your term and participate in the *Redemptive Compassion Study* within the first 6 months of beginning your term.
7. We hope that each board member will prayerfully guide Love In the Name of Christ of Central Oregon to success in fulfilling its mission: *mobilizing local churches to transform lives and communities in the Name of Christ.*
